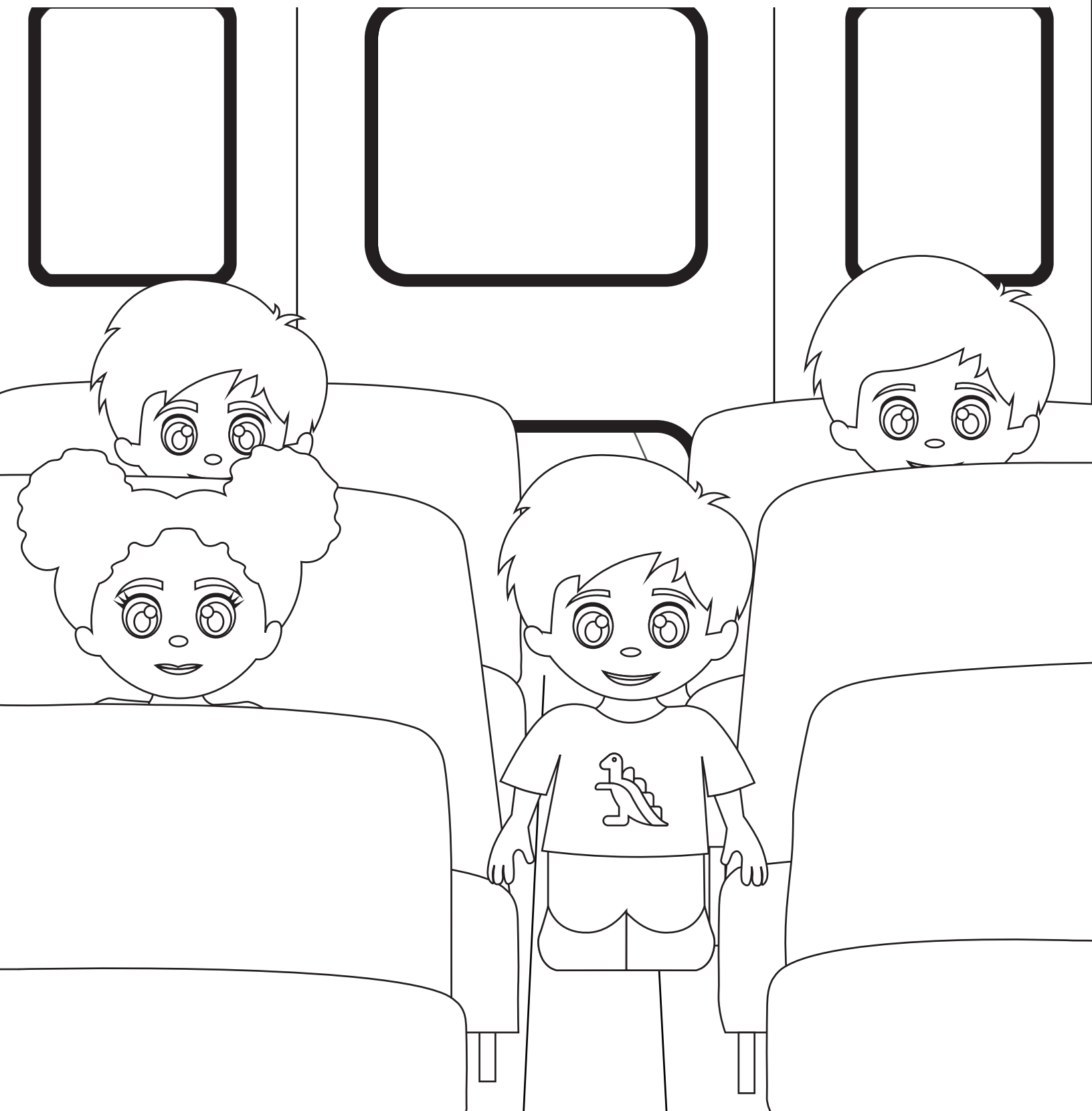
Lily climbed aboard. The bus was warm and cozy inside, and the seats were just the right size. There were other kids on the bus, and Lily chose a seat by the window.



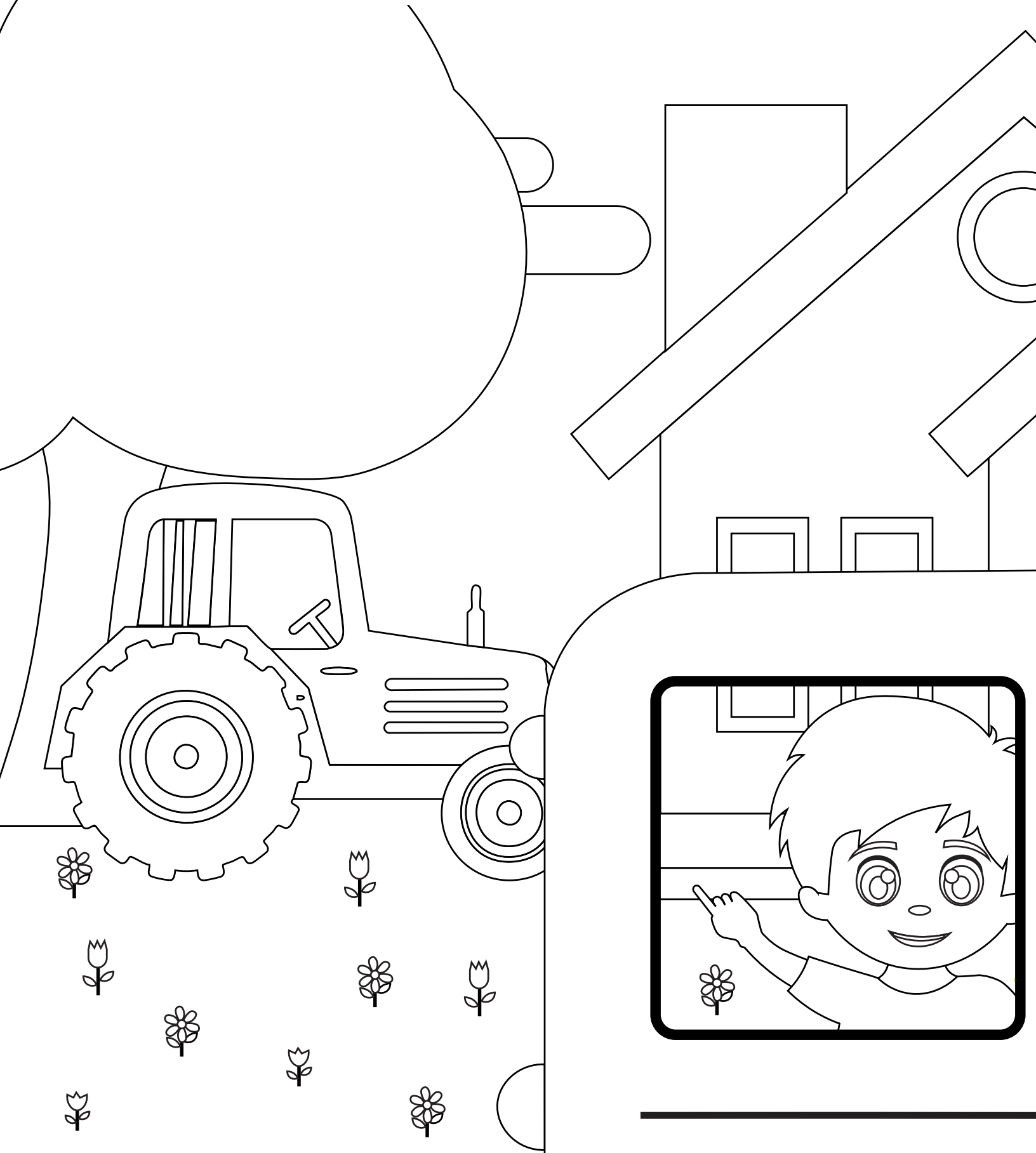

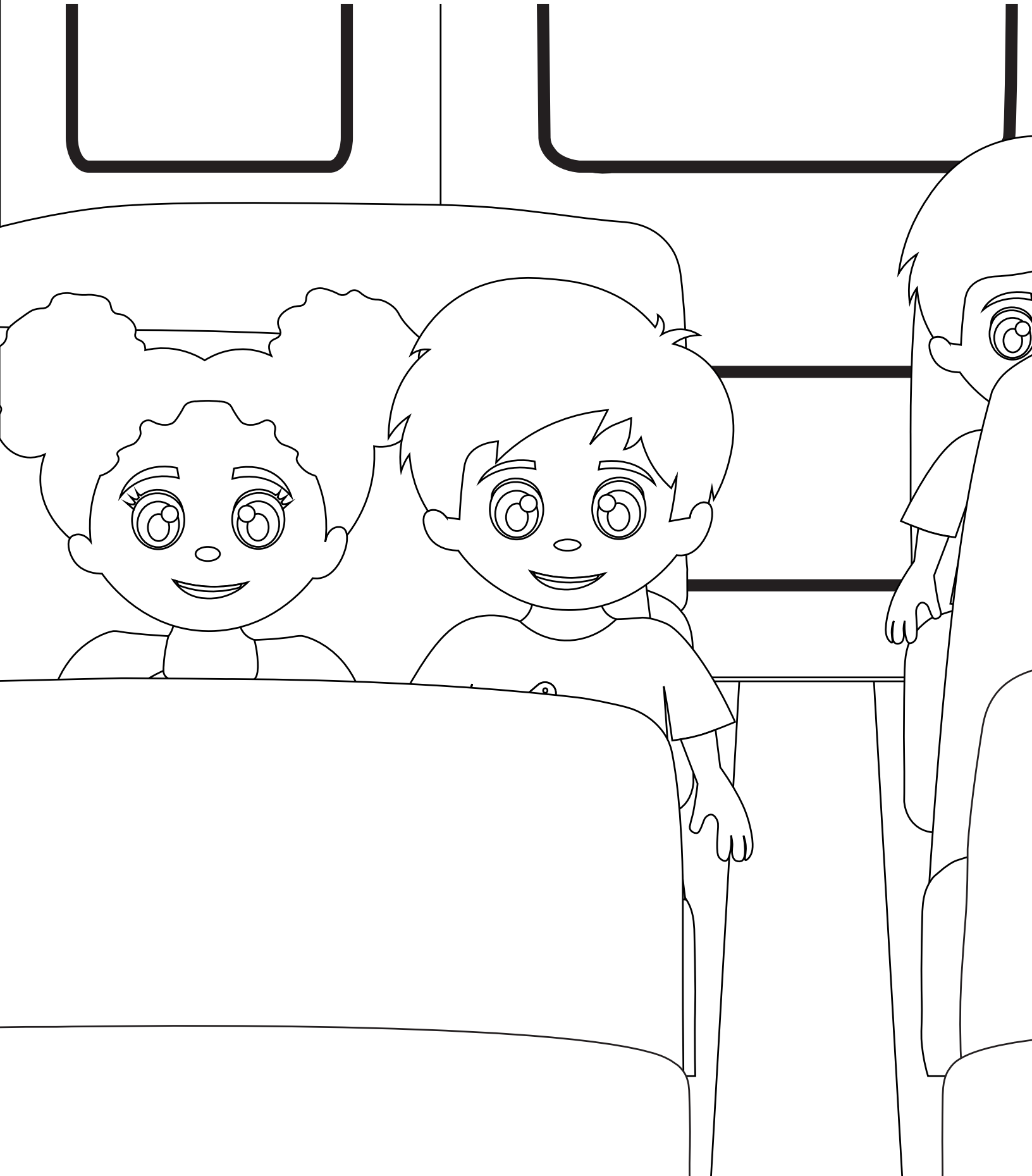


At the end of the day, the ride home was even better.

Lily and Milo saw more exciting sights...



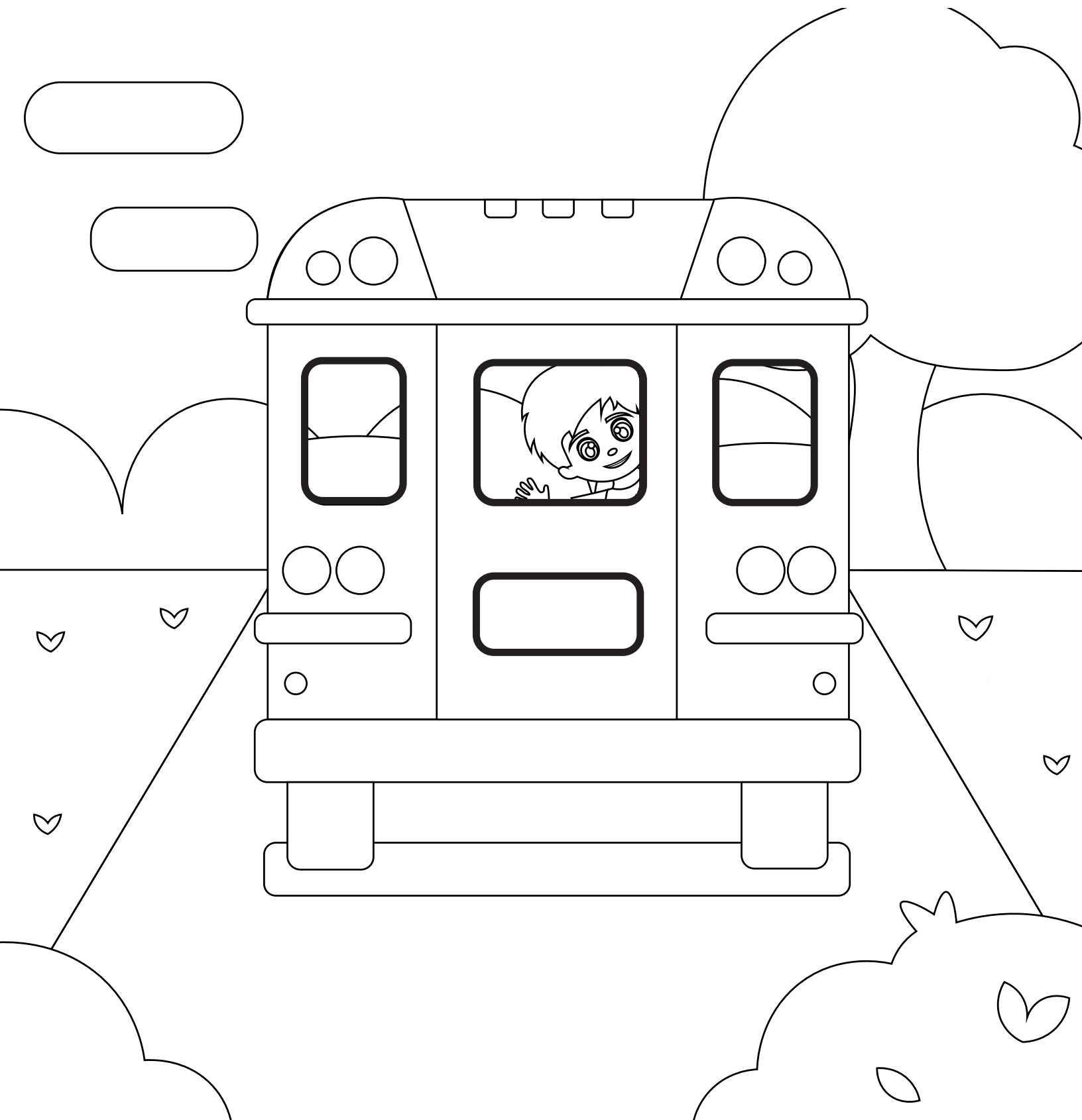
Lily and Milo laughed and shared stories about their school day. The ride home seemed to go by so fast as they were having such a good time together.

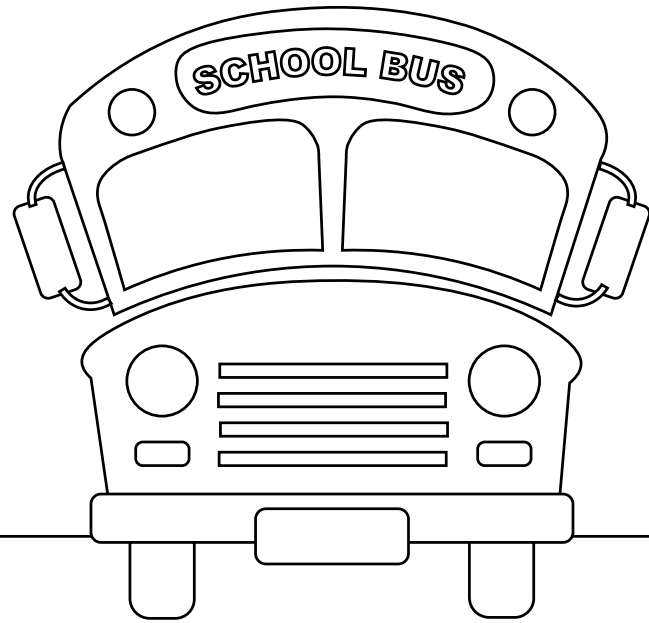
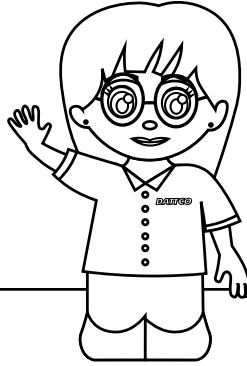

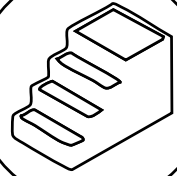


SCHOOL BUS SAFETY TIPS

Never throw things on the bus or out the windows



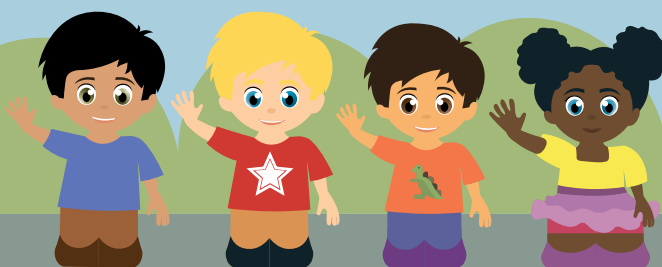
Keep the aisles/floor clear at all times
